

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE TISSOT RBS 6 NATIONS CONTEST

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN THIS CONTEST.

1. These terms and conditions ("the Rules") govern the "Tissot RBS 6 Nations" contest ("the Contest") administered by Six Nations Rugby Ltd., with its principal place of business on Simmonscourt Road, Ballsbridge, Dublin 4, Ireland ("6 Nations"), in collaboration with Tissot Ltd., based at Chemin des Tourelles 17, 2400 Le Locle, Switzerland ("Tissot").
2. By entering, you accept and agree to abide by the Rules. 7. The provision of any invalid, incorrect, or misleading personal information may result in disqualification from the Contest and/or receipt of the prize.
8. Incomplete, late, or otherwise faulty entries will not be accepted. 6 Nations and Tissot reserve the right to determine if an entry is valid and to disqualify anyone they reasonably believe to be tampering with the entry process, acting in a disruptive manner, or violating the Rules.
